White Wines

- 56 Chablis Valmur Grand Cru 2005** Domaine JC Bessin **France** **£45.00**
Valmur is one of only seven Grand Cru of Chablis, these are the biggest richest and most complex of all the wines. Valmur is renowned for its fine bouquet and ripe fruit. A great match to go with fish, particularly Dover Sole.
- 57 Ridge Monte Bello Chardonnay 2004** Santa Cruz **North America** **£65.00**
Highly sought after, Ridge is a Californian icon. This limited edition Chardonnay is grown in vineyards first planted in 1885. Under Paul Draper now harvesting his 38th vintage the wines have achieved world wine acclaim and a following to boot.
- 58 Puligny Montrachet Les Referts 1^{er} Cru 2005** Benoit Ente **France** **£78.00**
Benoit is one of Puligny's most exciting exponents. His vineyards were all planted by his grandfather in the 1950's and the wines are powerful and express the terroir of each vineyard.
- 59 Corton Charlemagne Grand Cru 2004** Domaine Bertagna **France** **£110.00**
From Beaune the hill of Corton stands out like a beacon, a sea of green vines topped with trees. A wonderful nose and on the palate gently creamy and beautifully pure with just a note of lemon minerality.

Rose Wine

- 60 Sancerre Rose 2007** Domaine Sautereau Les Espailles **France** **£31.00**
This is delicate salmon pink rose made from the Pinot Noir grape. Softly fruity with notes of strawberry and redcurrant and a clean mineral finish.

Red Wines

- 61 Clos Vougeot 2004** Domaine Rene Engel **France** **£110.00**
Clos Vougeot nestles in between the villages of Vosne Romanee and Chambolle Musigny in the Cote de Nuits. This is a genuine Clos and the largest walled vineyard in Burgundy established in 1100. Fine elegant and well poised.
- 62 Vega Sicilia Valbuena 2002** Ribera del Duero **Spain** **£120.00**
This vineyard was first planted in 1860 and bought by the Alvarez family in 1983. Valbuena is a mainly Tinto Finca blend with some Cabernet and Merlot added. A great wine with breeding and boundless potential.
- 63 Ridge Monte Bello 2004** Santa Cruz **North America** **£135.00**
The utterly brilliant Monte Bello compares with the very best that Bordeaux has to offer. Cabernet with Merlot, Petit Verdot and Cabernet Franc for good measure.
- 64 Ch Leoville Las Cases 1998 2eme Cru, St Julien** **France** **£175.00**
Since the late 70's Leoville has been knocking on the door of the First Growths, indeed her vineyards back onto those of Ch Latour. An impressive wine with ripe rich fruits combining together with concentrated cedar and spice notes.
